Kindergarten



The following items will be needed for your child in class. Some of the items will be specifically for your child to use; others will be for sharing with the entire class during the year. Please send them with your child by the beginning of next week.

Items Needed (Mark names on these items)

- Backpack (name or initials written on or inside the backpack)
- Non-marking gym shoes (to be left at school for gym class)
- Additional set of clothes in case of food spill or toileting accident. (Place in plastic bag with your child's name on the outside.)
- Ear buds for computer (small plug)

Items Needed (DO NOT mark names on these items)

- Child scissors
- Tissues (two or more boxes)
- 2 containers of hand sanitizer (large bottles)
- 2 containers of Clorox wipes (large containers)
- Washable markers (one box with 8 colors, broad tip)
- Crayons (two boxes of at least 24 colors)
- Dry erase markers (one box of 4)
- Elmer's glue sticks (4 large packages)
- 2 packs of pencils

- 1 roll of paper towel
- 1 box of ziplock sandwich baggies
- 1 box of ziplock snack baggies
- 4 plain colored plastic pocket folders--standard size
